

**SACOME Anti-Trust Statement:**

The South Australian Chamber of Mines and Energy brings together member representatives and competitors from a variety of industries. SACOME staff and its members will avoid discussion and not play a role in the competitive decisions of its members or their employers, or in any way restrict competition not only in the resource and minerals industries but in any industry. This restriction includes the exchange of information concerning individual prices, rates, coverage's, market practices, claims settlement practices, or any other competitive aspect of an individual's company operation. SACOME recognises the possibility that the Association and its activities could be seen by some as an opportunity to engage in anticompetitive conduct. For this reason, SACOME has taken the opportunity, through this statement of policy, to make clear its unequivocal support for the policy of competition served by the antitrust laws and its uncompromising intent to comply strictly in all respects with these laws. Members are also encouraged to speak up immediately for the purpose of preventing any discussion falling outside these bounds.
