Fully funded training is now available for Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety. High quality skills at certificate level is widely acknowledged as integral to creating workplace safety knowledge, which assists to maintain workplace safety standards and creates a stronger South Australia's workforce.

This MAQOHSC funded training will make training fully accessible to people who do not hold a qualification, or who want to gain a higher level qualification than they already hold. Numerous advantages can be gained in upskilling qualifications, it allows participants to increase workplace productivity and provide greater job satisfaction, and could also lead to career advancement.

The WHS Cert IV course will be available and delivered on an online platform over a 12 month period, if required face to face training assistance can also be provided. The online platform delivery method will also offer a very flexible learning option and ensures all our stakeholders in rural and remote regions of South Australia will also have full access to this fully funded training opportunity.
